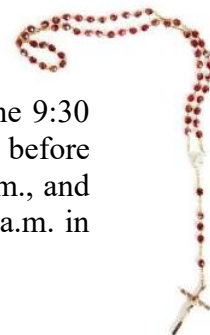

Solemn Profession of Vows as Sr. Faustina of the Most Precious Blood

Angela Marie Williams, daughter of Art and Jeannette Williams, was born and raised in Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish, baptized by Fr. John McBride on Palm Sunday, 1997. After a year of college, she discerned a vocation to the Discalced Carmelites, and seven years later, on October 27, 2024, she made her Solemn Profession of Vows as Sr. Faustina of the Most Precious Blood. She is a Discalced Carmelite Extern for the Carmel of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph in Fairfield, PA (www.fairfieldcarmelites.org).

Sr. Faustina's Carmel follows the original rule of their founder, St. Teresa of Avila. The primary work of the contemplative order is to pray the Liturgy of the Hours throughout the day, offering continual prayers and sacrifices for the Church and especially for priests. Since the primary work of the choir sisters is prayer, and since they are cloistered, they need help to get all the work done. Extern sisters, like Sr. Faustina, are not cloistered and engage with the outside world.

Sr. Faustina and the other externs are the "face of the Carmel" to those who come to visit. They also have scheduled prayer periods, but they are shorter to allow for more work to be done. They open the gate, answer questions, receive donations, and offer a kind word and a smile to visitors. They also interact with the world, making appointments, talking to builders, and writing thank you notes. Most importantly, they care for the chapel, tend flower beds and arrange flowers for the chapel, and organize the many elaborate liturgies so that the priests have everything they need. All this they do in a spirit of contemplation, as "contemplatives in action." All the sisters seem to exude joy.

Sr. Faustina "begs your prayers for herself and for all her community and promises to remember her parish family in her daily prayers. May God reward you."
