COME AND MEET US

Interested in learning more about the Catholic Church and becoming a Catholic?

The process by which adults come into the Church has become known as “the OCIA”, which is short for “The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults”.

Who is the process for:

1. Those un-baptized. The primary focus of the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is on those who are not already Christian and have not been catechized.
2. Those baptized, but un-catechized. Those who have been baptized either as Roman Catholics or as members of another Christian community but did not receive further catechetical formation or instruction. These typically have also not celebrated the Sacraments of Confirmation or Eucharist.
3. Those seeking full Catholic Communion. These are baptized practicing Christians from other denominations who seek entry into the Catholic Church.

In the case of children who have reached the age of reason, the Pastor should be consulted for information about Baptism and the other Sacraments of Initiation.

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults is not for adult candidates for Confirmation who have already received their First Eucharist in the Catholic Church. They should have their own formation process and be confirmed at a celebration other than the Easter Vigil.



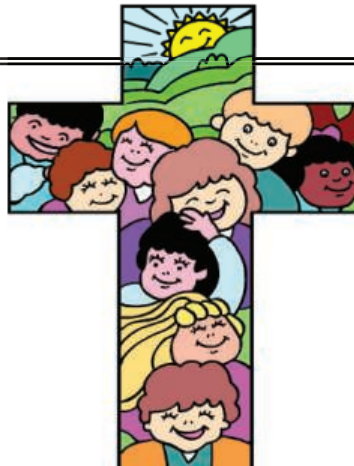
