Requirements for Baptism

- 1. Parents are registered members of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart.
 - If parents are registered at another parish, then you will need to obtain a Letter of Permission from your parish to allow the Baptism to take place at Our Lady of the Sacred Heart.

2. Required to attend Pre-Jordan Class BEFORE the child is born. Pre-registration is required, and please contact the Parish Office to register. Classes are held every other month.

3. ALL Baptism paperwork including the "Sacristy Record of Baptism" Form, Godparent(s) Certificate of Eligibilities, copy of Baptismal Certificate (Christian Witness ONLY), and Letter of Permission from another Parish (if applicable) must be submitted BEFORE we can schedule the Baptism Date.

Godparent(s) Information

Parents, before asking someone to be a godparent/sponsor must be aware of the Church's qualifications for one to be a godparent/sponsor. The choosing of godparents/sponsors is a very important decision, because he/she/they are to bear the responsibility to assist the parents in the raising of the child in the Catholic Faith.

The following are the requirements stated in Canon Law (Church Law #874):

- **†** One must be 16 years of age or older,
- ★ One must have received the Sacraments of Initiation Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation,
- ★ If one is married, the marriage must have been witnessed by a Catholic priest or have special permission approved by the Archbishop,
- + One must be presently active in the practice of the Faith by attending Sunday Mass and receiving the Sacraments regularly,
- A person who has left the Catholic Faith for any reason, may not be asked to carry out this responsibility.

You may have one or two godparent(s), and one must be a practicing Catholic. You may have a Christian Witness as the second godparent:

Christian Witness - Baptized non-denomination Christian. If someone was only Baptized Catholic, they are not considered a Christian Witness.

Godparent(s) must obtain:

- Catholic Certificate of Eligibility from the church they are registered members of.
- Christian Witness Copy of their Baptismal Certificate.

All certificates must be included along with the Baptism paperwork to be submitted to the Parish Office before the Baptism can be scheduled.
