## Restoration & Sustainability Campaign Newsletter

Many Hands Make Light Work

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish,

Life is certainly full of surprises. When I assumed the responsibility as your Parochial Administrator in June, I was delighted to learn that Our Lady of the Sacred Heart Parish had recently launched a Restoration and Sustainability Campaign to raise funds for needed building projects throughout the parish campus. However, the need for these improvements was felt sooner than expected when our Church lighting and air conditioning systems stopped working during a July heatwave. The foresight and generosity of this Parish community is truly a blessing.

As the Restoration and Sustainability Campaign approaches the half-year mark, I wanted to share with the Parish Community some updates regarding the status of the campaign and the progress on the projects. During the June Finance and Facilities Council meeting, the Council prioritized three projects as most urgent:

- A new water purification system and water tank for the Parish Life Center
- The new roof for the Church
- The replacement of the Church lighting system

As of July, the lighting design has been completed and the project is now ready to go to bid. Also, the water system project should be ready for bid by the end of July. Our roofing project is moving along, with discussions regarding materials and timelines continuing.

I would like to extend my deepest gratitude to our generous parishioners who have already pledged and donated towards the campaign. None of these necessary projects would be possible without your charity and financial support.

However, as our campaign slogan states, "*Many Hands Make Light Work*;" therefore, I invite any of you who have not submitted a pledge to please consider donating towards these needed repairs. There is still plenty of time for you join our Parish effort, and additional information about the campaign and pledging is provided in this newsletter.

As we move through this campaign and the completion of these projects, I am sure we will encounter many other "surprises" along the way. But with your prayers, support, and generosity, I know we will accomplish all we hope to achieve.

Can I still make a pledge to the campaign?


Answer: **Yes, please**! You can make a pledge or donation to the campaign at any point during the next 3 years. A pledge form is included on page 3 of this newsletter.
