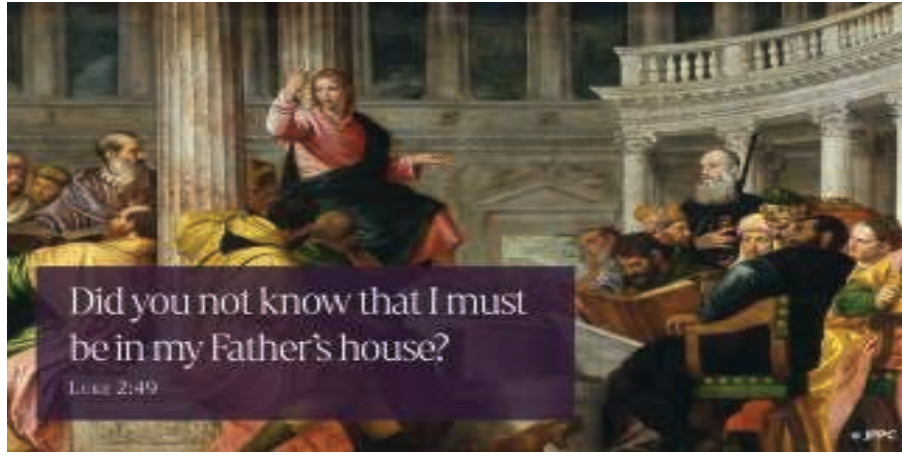

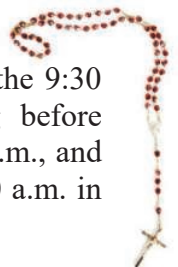
Litany and Perpetual Novena to St. Peregrine is prayed Thursdays immediately following morning Mass in the Church.
